**What to wear to class:** All female students are expected to wear a leotard to class. You may layer skirts or tutus, shorts or leggings, tank tops or t-shirts over top. Tights are recommended. Dancers must wear their hair secured off their face. Boys can wear athletic shorts and t-shirts.

We can order your shoes! Our prices are between \$5-15 cheaper than other stores and we save you shipping and gas money! Please visit the studio during normal business hours. It is fine to wear socks to your first classes until your shoes arrive. 5-7 grade and 8-12 grade jazz/hip hop will not order shoes until costumes are chosen, in the mean time wear other dance shoes or socks. Everyone else should have thier correct dance shoes by October. Absolutely NO street shoes may be worn on the dance floor.

Costumes- We will be sizing dancers during class time and ordering costumes for recital as early as the end of October. Costumes generally run around \$70 which we will take a deposit of \$35 in October and \$35 in November. We will not order costumes if your deposits are not paid which may delay arrival of your costumes. Late order will also be subject to additional shipping and handling costs.

**Bring a Friend Week-** During the weeks of Sept 24-27 and Oct 22-25, dancers are encouraged to invite a friend (who doesn't already take dance at ISDC) to try out their dance class for FREE. Invitations will be passed out to dancers during class and are available at the desk. Friends must have a completed waiver to participate. Dancers and their friends will receive a special treat.

Want a way to earn free money off your dance account? For every new friend you refer to ISDC and that completes a year of dance earns you money!! And dance is more fun with a friend. \$30 for each new dancer will be applied to your May tuition. Stop by the front desk during class time to fill out your referral cards so we can keep track for you. We are still accepting registration for many of our classes.

Costume Party Week- October 24 (Weds) thru October 30 (Tues) dancers are welcome to dress in a costume for dance class. It can be their Halloween costume or an old dance costume, just as long as they can move freely and no masks or weapons. The studio will be closed Wednesday, October 31 for



# Manage your Dance Account

You can now log on to your account to view your class day(s) and times and pay your tuition. Click on the Customer Account button at <a href="www.isdcdance.com">www.isdcdance.com</a>. Your user name is your email address. If you have forgotten your password or need to set one up, click the "I need a password" button and the system will send you one. Once in your account you can set your password to be memorable to you. Please verify all information and update any changes.

Starting October 1st, tuition is due on the first day of each month, regardless of the day your child attends class. Late accounts will be charged a \$10 late fee. Tuition charges will be applied to dance accounts by the 15th of the previous month.

**Set your account for automatic payments:** We can charge the credit card on file for all items due on the first of the month for you so you won't need to worry about late payments. Stop

by the front desk or set it up in your parent portal.
