DRESS REHEARSAL: ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

LOCATION: MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL (800 AMRINE MILL RD) - ALUMNI HALL ENTRANCE

To ensure a timely dress rehearsal, please arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time dressed in your first costume and tights. **Please check your schedules; Rehearsal is different from Recital.** We understand that you work, and the arrival time can be tricky. We want to ensure that our dancers are finished at a reasonable time that night, so an early start time is necessary. A timely dress rehearsal requires that each group is dressed and ready to go at start time. Upon arrival, you will bring your child directly to the check-in station. No parents, except assigned backstage moms, will be permitted past the check-in point. Student assistants will escort children to the dressing room. Please note that this is a working dress rehearsal. We run a very professional recital because we work through all the bugs at dress rehearsal. Please be patient if there is a delay or glitch during rehearsal. We will do everything we can to keep the rehearsal running as smoothly as possible.

We will run the finale number first, followed by the rehearsal order. **Dancers do not need to wear their finale outfits; Arrive in first costume.** Make sure to send all costumes and shoes with your child to the dressing room. Dancers cannot come into the auditorium to gather belongings. **You and your child are free to leave once they have completed their dance numbers.** For dancers age 2-grade 2: one family member can pick them up at the check-in station. For dancers grade 3-12: they will be dismissed to Alumni Hall, so a parent will not need to pick them up. Please have a conversation with your child about where to meet.

Dress rehearsal is a closed event. Only two parents/guardians may sit in the auditorium to watch. You are welcome to take photos and videos during dress rehearsal. However, out of respect for our dancers and the people sitting around you, **NO photography or video recording will be permitted during recital.** Sit back, relax, and enjoy the show! You will receive a professional video download that will include still pictures of all the recitals. Feel free to take pictures outside of the auditorium before or after the show.

BACKSTAGE/DRESSING ROOM

Please remember that dressing rooms are a private changing area. **Absolutely no men or boys will be allowed access to the backstage hallway.** There will be a separate area for our male dancers. Students must respect other students and their property in the dressing rooms. The students will spend more time in the dressing than on stage, so please do your best to keep them organized and clean. Double check your bag before you go home for the night. We cannot be responsible for anything left in the dressing rooms or in the auditorium.



MAKEUP

Makeup application is encouraged for all dancers at dress rehearsal as well as recital to ensure that your dancer's face can be seen onstage and on the video. Without makeup, the bright stage lights can wash out their faces and their features can disappear.

We recommend the following makeup on Recital Day. Please use discretion with how much you apply in relation to the age of your child.

- Foundation: Older dancers should apply a color that matches their skin tone to the entire face including eyelids. Blend well, especially at the chin and neck. This helps your makeup to stay in place during the show.
- Blush: Apply under the cheekbone. Place two fingers next to the nose and apply blush from this point back to the hairline.
- Lipstick: Line lips with a lip liner pencil and fill in with lipstick. Blot gently without rubbing lips together. Add a dot of gloss in the center of the bottom lip.
- Eyeliner: Use black or dark brown pencil at the base of the lash line on the outer 2/3rds of the eye. On older dancers, you can extend the line past the outer corner of the eye just a little bit.
- Mascara: Use black mascara on the upper eyelashes. Please apply more than one coat. False eyelashes are always encouraged on older dancers and really make their eyes open up!
- Eye Shadow: Use warm colors such as brown or dark gray (not blue) in the crease of the eyelid. Use light cream on the brow bone and the inside corner of the eye. Blend well!
- Powder: A dusting of skin-colored powder over the face sets the makeup and reduces shine. Glitter is always nice too!

HAIR

We do not require a specific hairstyle for each class for the recital (unless you are a competition dancer). We do however ask that bangs and hair be pulled off of the face. Have fun styling your dancer's hair: curls, updos, glitter, etc. are fine. If a hair accessory came with the costume, it should be worn on the student's left side.

UNDERGARMENTS & COSTUMES

No underwear is to be worn on dress rehearsal or recital day. We do not want to see panty lines! Tan bras or nude leotards are encouraged for those dancers that need them. Please be sure you have clear straps on these items. If the costume has pants, dancers still need to wear tights underneath! The tights act as their underwear. The audience's eyes are at the level of the dancers' feet so they can see their ankles while dancing. It looks more professional to have tights on. Be sure to have your dancer try their dance in their costume at home so you can SECURE any places the costume doesn't stay put. Check for shirts that ride up and expose the midriff, pants that don't stay up over slippery tights, and bras that peek out. We don't want any costume malfunctions on the day of the show!

PACKING FOR DRESS REHEARSAL & RECITAL

We recommend using a basket or bucket (something that will stand up on its own) to pack for the dressing room. Label the outside with your dancer's name, class(es) and costume orders. Inside the basket, layer the costumes in order from last to first. On the bottom should be the labeled finale shirt and black bottoms, if needed. On top of that should be whichever dance performs last (for instance: tap shoes and tap skirt), followed by the next, and so on. Dancers should arrive at both rehearsal and recital wearing their first costume and tights. You can also pack emergency items like bobby pins, hairspray, and makeup for touch ups. Water can also be included in this basket.



REMEMBER TO LABEL EVERYTHING!!!

FINALE OUTFIT

Finale t-shirts will be passed out in class during the next few weeks. **For students grade 1-12, they can wear any black bottoms they already own.** Black shorts, leggings, or athletic pants are all acceptable. **For students in Combo and Intro, we will put the shirt over their costumes (black bottoms not needed).** All dancers must wear jazz or ballet shoes (if your dancer is only in tap, they will need to go barefoot). Your child will not be permitted to dance in the finale without the finale t-shirt. The finale outfit does not need to be worn at dress rehearsal. LABEL EVERYTHING! Everyone has the same shirt.



RECITAL DAY: ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

LOCATION: MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL (800 AMRINE MILL RD) - ALUMNI HALL ENTRANCE

Please arrive 20-30 minutes prior to your recital time with your child fully dressed and ready in their first costume, minus their dance shoes. We are having multiple recitals this day.

Please do not arrive early. The recital before yours will still be performing, so parking might be tricky and the hallways will be congested. Upon arrival, take your dancer with their costume basket to the check-in station. No parents will be permitted in the backstage area. For our students' safety, only assigned backstage helpers, dancers, and staff are allowed past the check-in station. Make sure your child has their finale shirt and black bottoms (for grades 1-12). We will not have extras for dancers who forgot theirs.



Students will remain backstage for the entire performance. All younger students will be under the supervision of responsible adults and dance assistants. For dancers age 2-grade 2, one adult family member must come to the check-in/check-out table before picking up your child at the end of the show. If you are a dad, our staff will be more than happy to retrieve your dancer for you. For dancers grade 3 - 12, they will be dismissed to Alumni Hall after the finale, so a parent does not need to come backstage to get them. Please have a conversation with your dancer about where to meet.

Recital dismissal will be streamlined into Alumni Hall for a quick dancer meet-and-greet after the recital. It is important that you do not congregate in the dressing rooms so we can prepare for the next recital. If you are not planning to meet the dancers, you may exit to the parking lot. This meet-and-greet area will be open to you for 10 minutes after the show at which time we will ask our families and friends to exit the building.

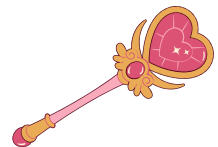


MINI ROYALTY IN TRAINING: AGES 3-4
